My First Visit to RMC-AoG

Because we place so much value over your life and appreciate your fellowshiping with us, whether a member, regular visitor or first time visitor, we are delighted to give you a general overview of our church; what we do and where to find things. If you have any questions or concerns, please just speak to one of our leaders or the person who welcomed you at the door.

You probably entered via the main entrance in the café area. Our TOILETS are located there and drinks are serviced from the counter there after served.

The CHILDREN have their service in the SMALL HALL which is accessible through the main gates by the side of the church. Our Sunday celebration start at 1:30pm and usually last for about 3 hours with exciting moments with the Lord and one another. In our service, allow the Holy Spirit to lead and direct in the following activities:

SETTING THE ALTERS: Powerful, Passionate Intercessory Prayer session on all issues and also seeking the Holy Spirit's leading for the day.

SUNDAY SCHOOL: A time to discuss and systematically study the Word of God for all age groups. You will be allocated a class by the superintendent who will also give you a Sunday School book (6 monthly manual).

PRAISES & WORSHIP: Our worship is celebrated with singing, drumming, clapping and dancing. You will hear shouts of "Praise the Lord", "Hallelujah", "Amen" and many more as an expression of joy, praise and grace. Songs and hymns are picked from all over the world and we sing, clap and dance to the glory of God. You will find the words

of the songs on the screen so you can sing along.

WELCOME & ANNOUNCEMENTS: It's our custom to warmly welcome everyone at every service and also throw emphases on forthcoming events and activities. We also acknowledge and celebrate with one another; Birthdays, Anniversaries, Weddings, Dedications, Travels, Successes and every special moment. Visitors and celebrates are prayed for by the ministerial team.

SONG MINISTRATION: Our choir; 'Echoes of the Crown' will treat you to a melodious music to settle and assure you of God's eminent presence.

OFFERINGS, TITHES, SACRIFICES, SEEDS and GIFTS: At every service, we give an opportunity for people to make monetary sacrifices, gifts, offerings, gifts, etc to the Lord. This is generous, spontaneous and voluntary showing of gratitude to the Lord at any time of the service. We also believe in tithing (10 percent of your increase) as stated in the Holy Scriptures to be paid weekly or monthly depending on the individual. We encourage that all monetary offerings be put in envelopes and GIFT AIDED if you are a UK tax payer.

WORD MINISTRATION: We believe in the Holy Scriptures (Old & New Testament, excluding the apocrypha) as God's Word to us. Readings are made from the Bible and therefore everyone is encouraged to personally own one. At every service, we allow the Lord to speak to us through His servant. Our speakers are Spirit-filled people of God who take time to pray, study obtain revelation from God and passionately share with us. We acknowledge the office and

ministry of Pastors, Apostles, Prophets, Teachers and Evangelist operating in the spiritual gifts to edify and build the body of Christ. Our sermon times are very interactive, educative and prophetic and people in a relaxed mode react to the power of the Word. Questions are not allowed on Sundays. However, if you are unsure about anything, you can come to our Friday teaching service.

COMMUNION SERVICE: Our Lord Jesus Christ encourages us to observe the Holy Communion as often as we can. We do this monthly (1st Sunday of the month) and it is not for only members of our local church or Assemblies of God but rather all believers (including visitors). You are welcomed to partake of it if you are a believer regardless of your denomination.

PRAYER & FELLOWSHIP: We believe in the power of prayer and the assurance of the Lord to hear our request and answer our needs. Therefore our services are spiced with powerful prophetic prayers which we all do in your own words and understanding. Added to congregational prayers, the ministers will also pray with and for you regarding anything and everything. There are testimonies of God's miraculous hands in our gatherings.

HOME CELL FELLOWSHIP: As part of our community impact programme, and also to interact with the community, we hold monthly home fellowships all across London. This is where members who live in a particular community, invite neighbours and friend to their home for a cup of tea, coffee, soft drinks and biscuits. After which they pray for their street and community. There is a home group near you and I encourage you to link up and enjoy fellowship in a small group (Eltham, Orpington, Catford, Lewisham, North London and Woolwich).

young people don't like it, but that's what makes him a good father. He shields them from danger, stands in their way from trouble and protects them from evil.

2) PROVIDER: a good father provides for his family. Not only money, food and clothing, but he also provides insight, shares wisdom, becomes a friend, gives perspective, academic support, gives advice and is always around, when needed by the family.

3) PRIEST: a good father is a priest to his wife and children. He studies the Word of God and shares with his family. He spends time to pray FOR his family and WITH his family Luke 18:1. He cares about and masterminds the spiritual wellbeing of his family. He is the pillar on which the family depends spiritually.

4) PROMOTER: a good father promotes the wellbeing of his family. He puts his wife and children first before himself. A good father knows that it's not all about him, but it's about the legacy that he leaves that matters and counts. In Proverbs 20:7 Bible' says that "The just man walketh in his integrity: his children are blessed after him." A good man makes his wife and kids look good.

5) PROPHET: a good man is a prophet to his family. He prophesies goodness and destiny into the life of his kids. He tells them what they CAN do and neutralises any negativity that the children bring from outside. A good man speaks life and encourages the children to aspire to greater heights in life. In Genesis 35:18, Jacob changed Benjamin's name from Benoni (son of my sorrows) and out of Benjamin came kings that ruled in Israel.

As we celebrate Father's Day on Sunday the 16th of June, I want to take this opportunity to wish every Father and every man who aspires to be a father a very Happy Father's Day. As we know, God is the greatest example of fathers that has ever been. We are living in a generation where Good fathers are hard to find. There are many homes in our world today with children and mothers but lack the presence of good legitimate fathers. This has caused a major deterioration of the moral fibre of our society especially among young men. The statistic is staggering for absent - father homes in a study conducted in the US by the US Census. For children who grow up in homes without a father; - in the USA, 1 in 3 children live without a father

These children;
- are 5 times more likely to be poor
- are twice as likely to drop out of school
- they are more likely to engage in premarital sexual activities
- they have lower GPAs, poorer attendance at school, higher criminal rates and more likely to be in trouble with the law than their counterparts who live in homes with fathers. On the reflection of these statistics I will like to share 5 characteristics that define the PORTRAIT OF A GOOD FATHER

1) PROTECTOR: a good father will always look for his children and knows where they are and what they are doing. The children and especially the






